1. The EAW, a former AEG plant, was under SAG Kabel from whom the EAW received all its directives. The technical director was a Soviet named Dzhylin (German transliteration, Tulin) and the project director was a Soviet named Klinnoi (German transliteration). These two men were experts as far as the Germans knew. [redacted] no other Soviets at EAW nor directors in SAG. The EAW was composed of four separate works which were as follows: 25X1

- a. GRF - Gleichrichterbau
- b. SA - Schaltgeraete-Fabrik
- c. MS - Mess-Geraete-Fabrik and RF-Relais-Fabrik
- d. RAF - Radio-Fabrik

2. [redacted] assembling specification folders on switches (Geraetepass or Steckbriefe). [redacted] the technical aspects of the switch design and correct structural errors or impractical aspects. Some of the switches [redacted] and the production figures of these switches were as follows: 25X1

A large part of the number of switches produced were sent to the USSR and to the satellites. Some nameplates were made with Soviet lettering.

The pamphlet also deals with the obligations to the workers and is well seasoned with the usual propaganda.
