This report consists of a map with a legend indicating the location of Soviet Troop Units stationed in Kherson (N 46-40, E 32-35).

Legend to the map

1. Hospital; a two-story, red brick building, about 45 meters by 45 meters. No details were known.
2. Annex to the hospital; a two-story, red brick building, about 20 meters by 10 meters. No details were known.
3. Four casernes. Each contained an unknown number of two-story, red brick barracks, about 100 meters by 25 meters; each caserne also contained a training area and a target range. Source heard that an unidentified infantry regiment was stationed there. Before World War II, the 45th Infantry Regiment was stationed in these four casernes. No other details were known to source.

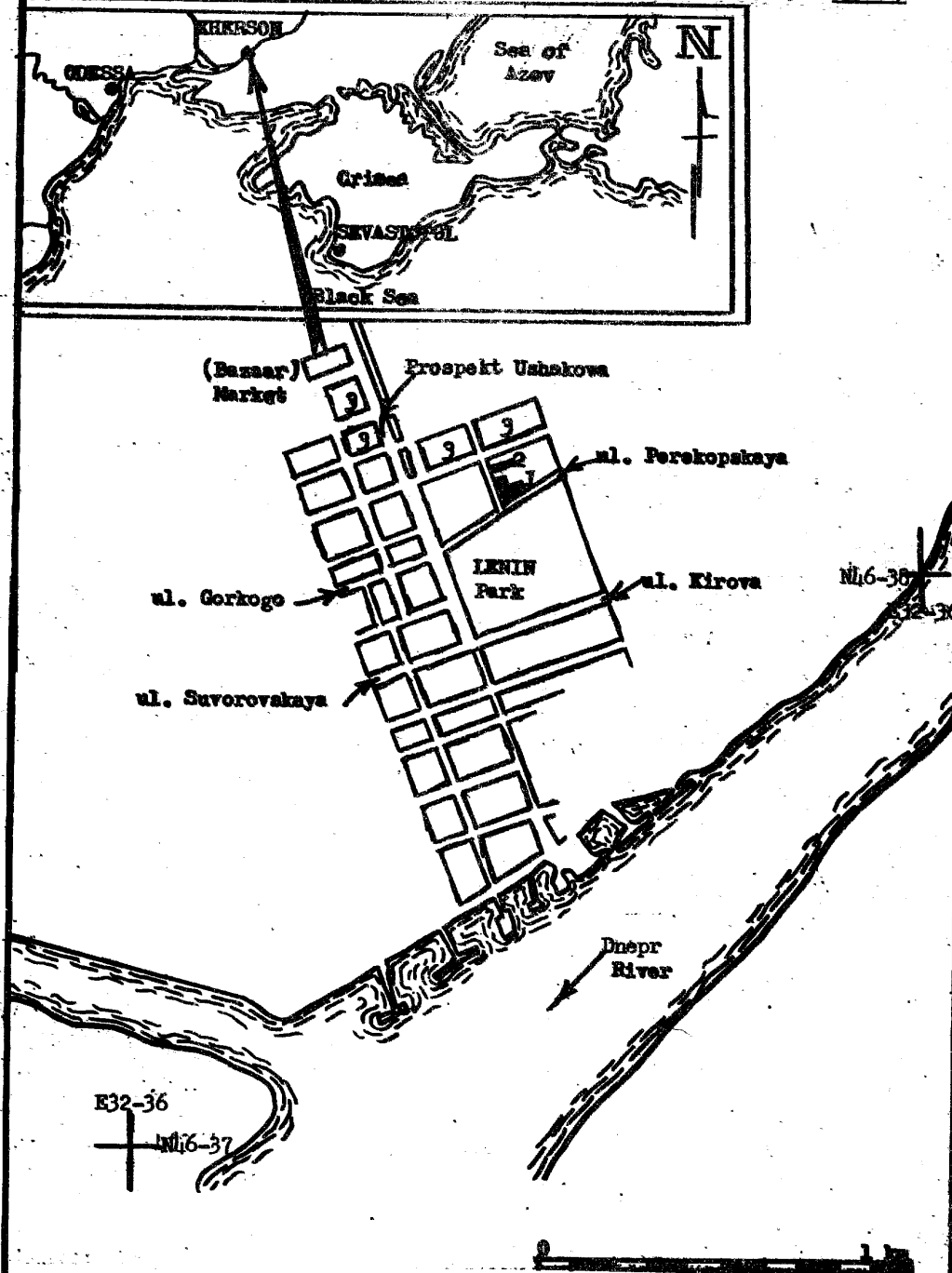
