1. On 23 March, a troop train composed of 30 converted boxcars with military personnel, two express train coaches with officers and eight flatcars loaded with trucks was observed at Frankfurt/Oder. The train was bound from Brest to Eberswalde. 1
2. A troop train bound from Brest to Eberswalde was observed at Frankfurt/Oder on 26 March. The train was composed of seven RR cars loaded with 12 rocket launchers, 12 trucks and ammunition and 14 converted boxcars with military personnel. 1
3. On 26 March, 16 AA guns, 16 trucks and military personnel were loaded at Frankfurt/Oder on a train destined for Cottbus. [REDACTED]
