- 1. Along strategic routes Soviet military authorities are installing subterranean depots for storing gasoline and mazut.
- 2. The tanks of these depots are standard metal construction and of 60-ton capacity. Generally, six tanks form a single depot; thus the average capacity of each depot is 360 tons.
- 3. The tanks are buried 6-12 m. underground and are located 200-800 m. away from the roads.
- 4. Depots of this type are known to be in the vicinity of the following localities:
