On 23 March [redacted] 380 RRym-type flatcars, which represented almost the entire stock, and most of the transit-worthy Om-type gondola cars without side racks of the Berlin regional railroad district were dispatched empty to Brest Litovsk.

[redacted] Comment. The dispatch of empty heavy-duty freight cars to the U.S.S.R. starting 8 February was reported previously. [redacted]. It is believed that these cars will be used for the shipment of tanks, weapons and equipment, possibly for the KVP.
