1. [REDACTED] more than ten Soviet advisors, accompanied by four Chinese Communist officers, arrived in Peihai (N 21-24, E 109-05).<sup>1</sup> They were quartered at T'ien Hai Lou, Chung Shan Lu (1131/3189/2869/0022/1472/6424).

2. [REDACTED] four Soviet advisors with an escort of more than ten Chinese Communist troops, arrived in Wuchou (N 23-28, E 111-19) from Nanning (N 22-48, E 108-18) aboard the SS P'ING AN (1627/1344). Local government officials met the Soviets at the wharf.

3. Two of the advisors went on to Canton; one took up residence at the Wuchou airfield; the fourth subsequently made frequent trips from the Wuchou Hsien government to the Wuchou Military District Headquarters.<sup>2</sup>
