1. Military shipments from Brest Litovsk observed at the Frankfurt/Oder railroad station between 16 and 26 March 1953 included: 6 flatcars with six JSU-122 tanks to Eberswalde on 16 March; ¹ 55 boxcars with ammunition to Eberswalde on 22 March; ² and 25 boxcars with ammunition to an undetermined receiving station on 26 March.

2. On 24 March, a shipment of 60 flatcars with trucks was observed at the Doberlugk-Kirchhain railroad station. The train came from the direction of Cottbus and went toward Halle. ³

3. Shipments from Brest Litovsk observed at the Frankfurt/Oder railroad station on 28 March and 2 April included: 6 flatcars with 6 trucks to Forst Zinna, 1 flatcar with 1 truck to Fuerstenwalde, and 3 flatcars with 3 trucks to Rostock on 28 March; and 3 flatcars with 3 trucks to Altuedersdorf, 1 flatcar with 2 trucks to Muellrose, and 2 flatcars with 3 trucks to Kammersdorf on 2 April.

1. Comment. The vehicles observed probably were not tanks but JSU-122 SP guns. Eberswalde is not believed to be the receiving station. The shipment possibly was for the KVP Armeegruppe Nord.

2. Comment. This ammunition shipment possibly was for the Waldemar ammunition depot northwest of Eberswalde. This, however, is contradicted by the fact that this depot has not received direct shipments from the USSR for years.

3. Comment. Dispatching and receiving stations of the shipment are unknown.

4. Comment. Probably small truck shipments of the regular supply program.
