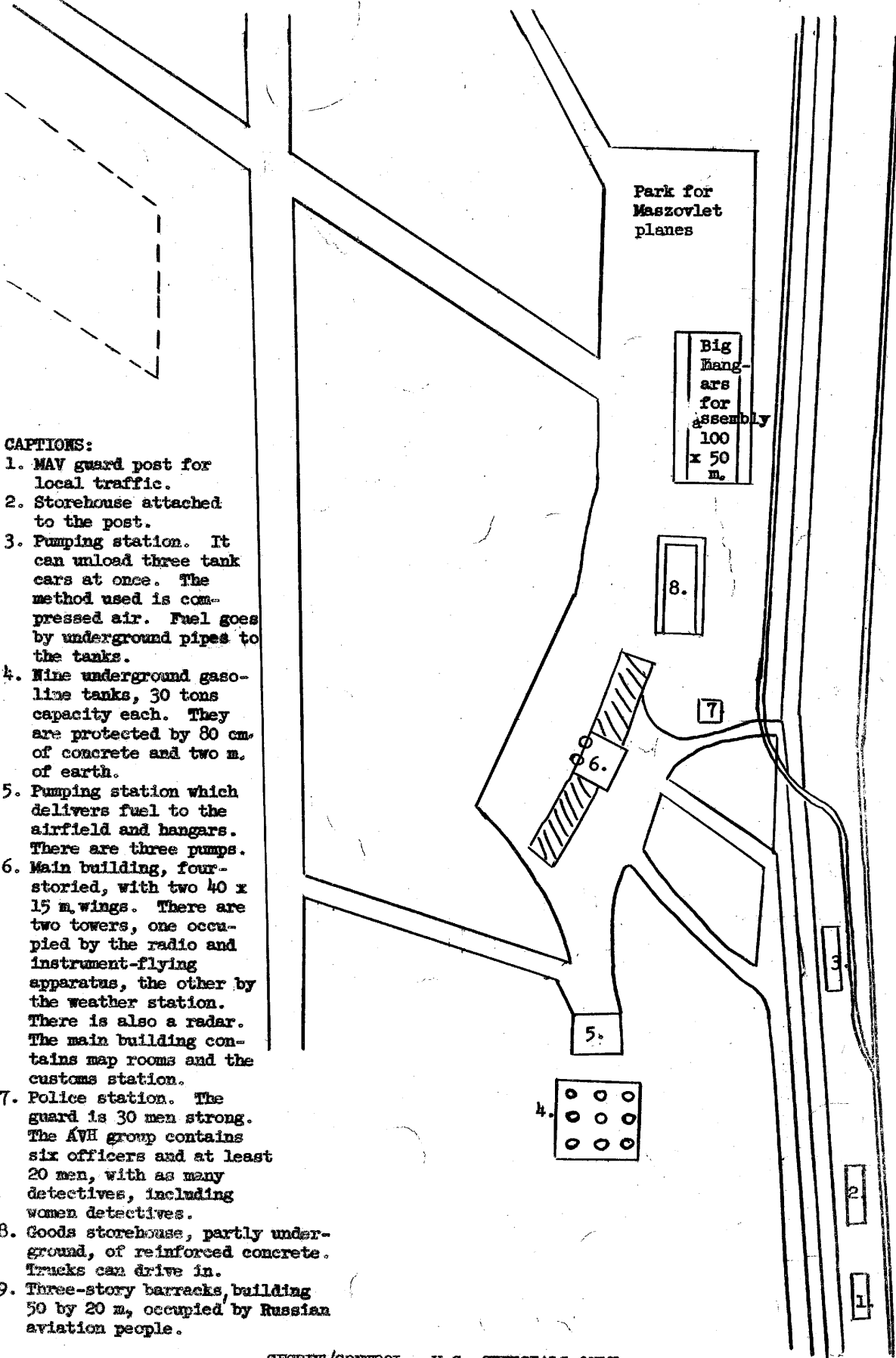

CAPTIONS:

1. MAV guard post for local traffic.
2. Storehouse attached to the post.
3. Pumping station. It can unload three tank cars at once. The method used is compressed air. Fuel goes by underground pipes to the tanks.
4. Nine underground gasoline tanks, 30 tons capacity each. They are protected by 80 cm. of concrete and two m. of earth.
5. Pumping station which delivers fuel to the airfield and hangars. There are three pumps.
6. Main building, four-storied, with two 40 x 15 m. wings. There are two towers, one occupied by the radio and instrument-flying apparatus, the other by the weather station. There is also a radar. The main building contains map rooms and the customs station.
7. Police station. The guard is 30 men strong. The AVH group contains six officers and at least 20 men, with as many detectives, including women detectives.
8. Goods storehouse, partly underground, of reinforced concrete. Trucks can drive in.
9. Three-story barracks, building 50 by 20 m, occupied by Russian aviation people.

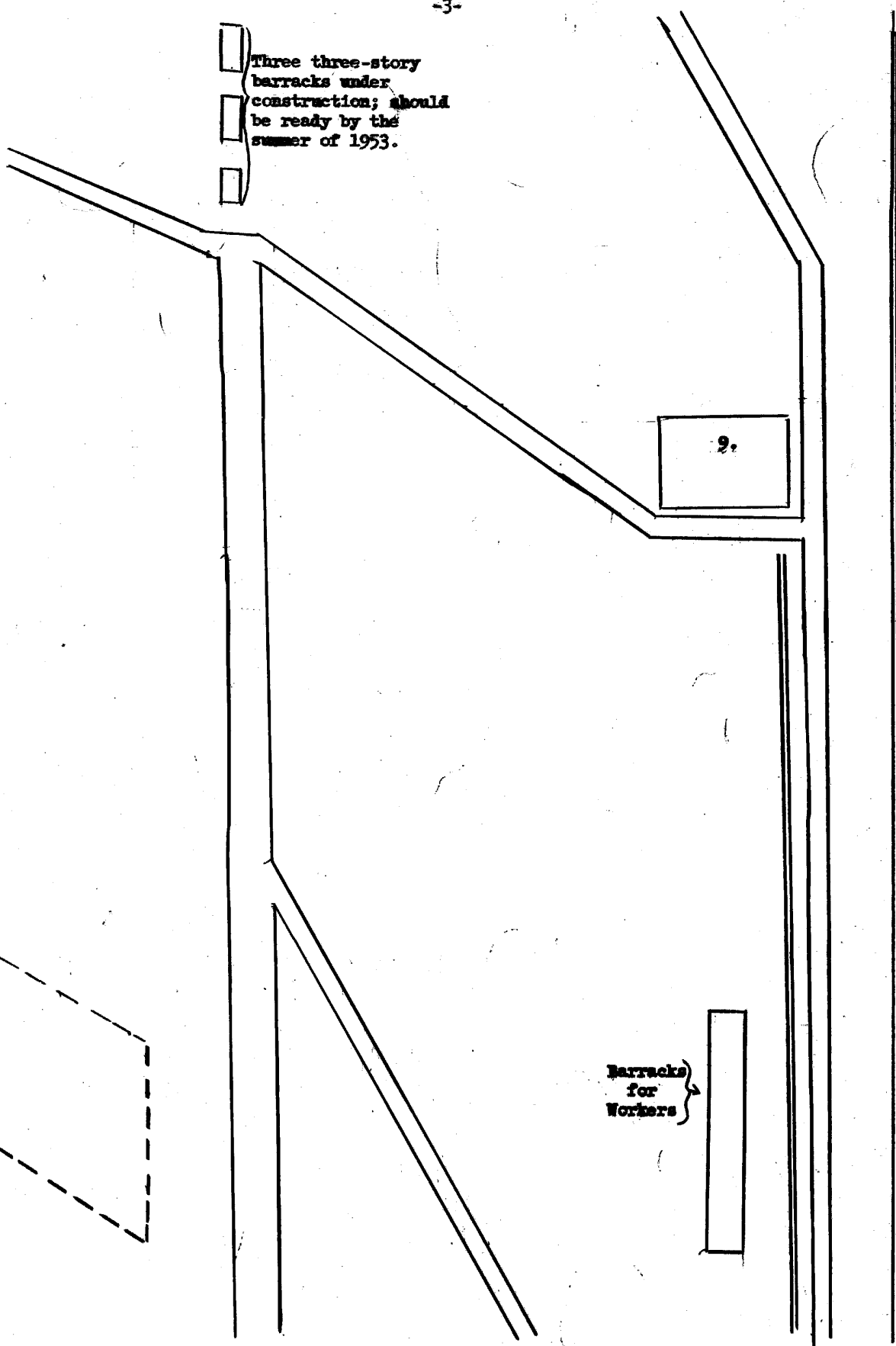
