1. Two trucks, [redacted] driven by airforce personnel were seen in the town of Vöslau on 13 March 1953.

2. On 14 March a number of blast pits were observed on the Vöslau-Kottingbrunn airfield. A row of eight pits are located along the eastern boundary with an undetermined number beyond and on a parallel with these. Signs prohibiting approach to the airfield are placed at the intersections of the two roads leading into the airfield from the main Günselsdorf-Oyenhausen road. No activity was observed at the airfield; no sentries or aircraft were seen.

3. A truck, [redacted] was noted in Vöslau on 22 March.

4. A sketch of the Vöslau-Kottingbrunn airfield and the surrounding area is attached.

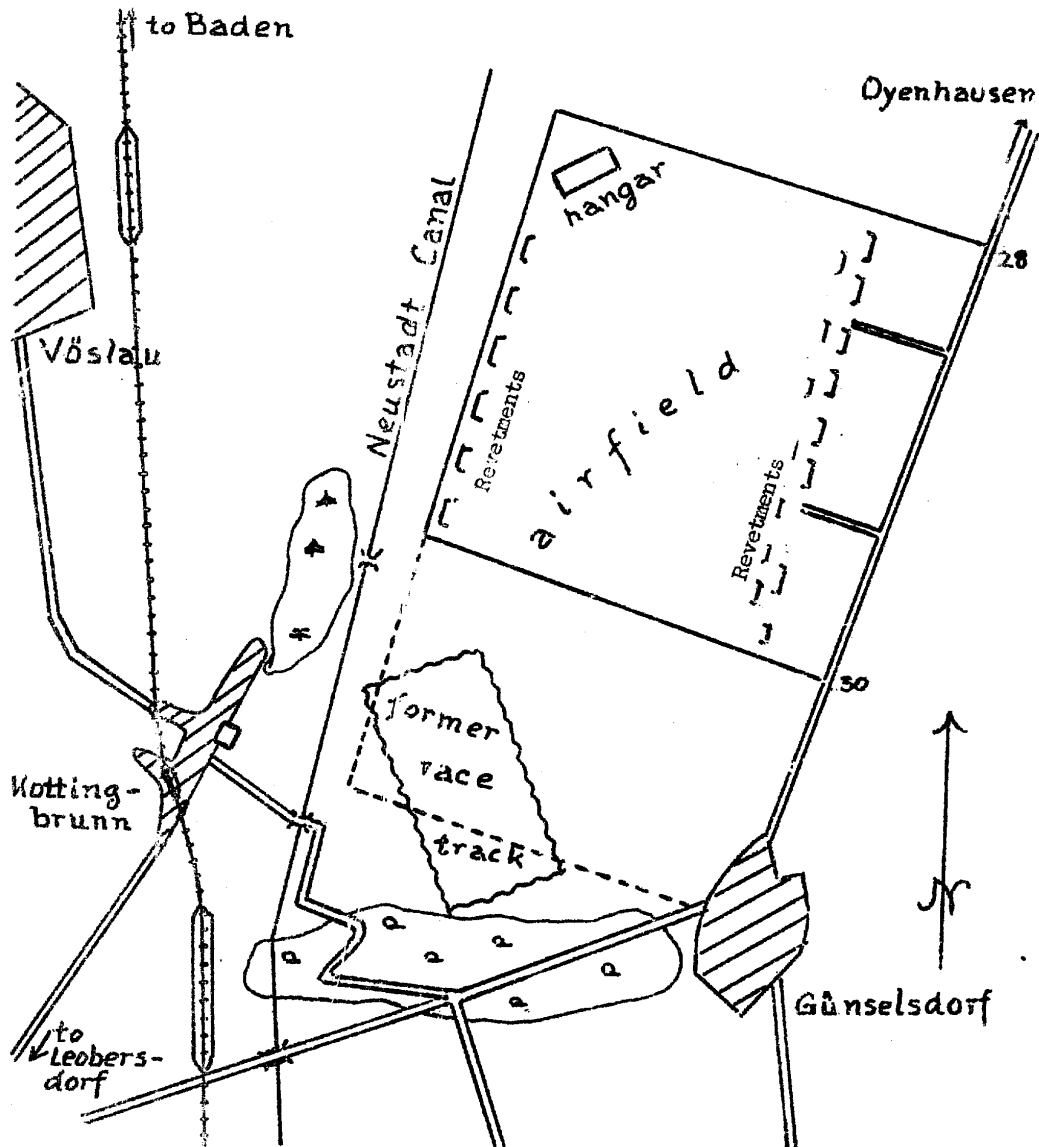
