1. Sixteen locomotives were detached from the Frankfurt-Brest-Litovsk run following an order of the Reichsbahn on 15 April. These were to be used for the shipment of troops and equipment from East Germany to the USSR. In this connection, forty tanks were being loaded at Frankfurt on 16 April. The withdrawal of the locomotives from their regular run has reduced the daily number of freight trains going from Frankfurt to Brest-Litovsk from about 13 to five.
2. During the period of three weeks prior to 16 April, trains from Frankfurt have been allowed to remain in Brest-Litovsk for only two to four hours. Only one train at a time has been allowed to cross the border.
