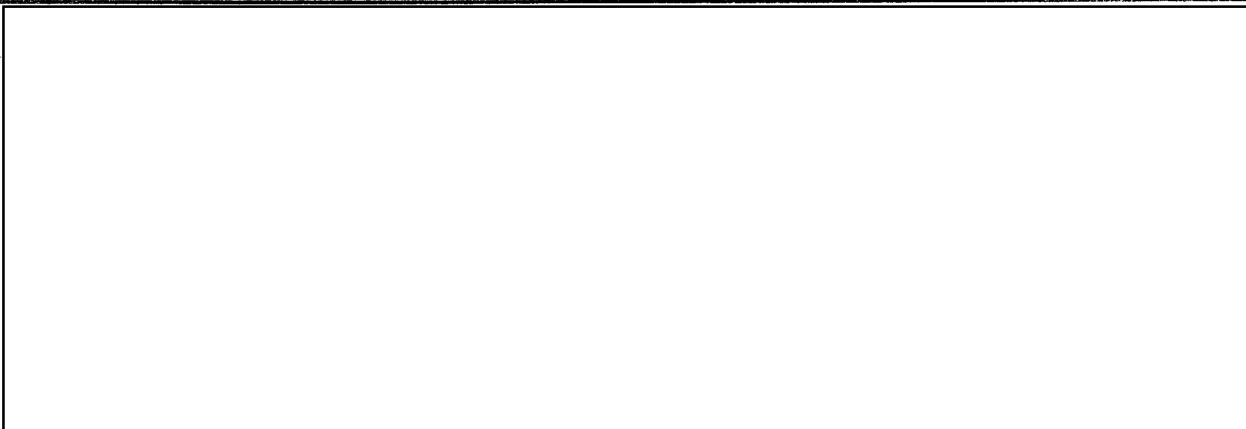

Khimki-- Rocket motors. Dr.PUTZE (now in West Germany), EISLER, SCHWARZ (now in West Germany), GRIMM.

Jena-- [Redacted] January 1952 300 former Zeiss employees were returned to East Germany and are now again at Jena.

Kimry (N 56 54, E 37 18)--100 to 150 Germans formerly employed by Siebel and Junkers work here. Chief of the group was Theodor SCHMIDT. No other names known. Approximately half of this group was returned to East Germany in the spring of 1952.

Krasnogorsk (N 55 51, E 37 19)--Optical plant. "Zorki" cameras are made here. Former Zeiss (Jena) employees work under Dr. ILLGEN. Other Zeiss employees work at an institute in Leningrad.

Leningrad--Gyroscope specialists: MUMERT, BOEGEL. Some former Leuna (chemical company) employees are in Leningrad; others are somewhere in the southern part of the USSR.

25X1 Monino (North Moscow)--Radio guidance for antiaircraft rockets under the Ministry for Communications. BUCKBECK [REDACTED] NEIDHARDT, EITZENBERGER, MOSER, KUEHN, HINTZE, FAULSTICH, OSTERMANN, Miss PETERS (secretary).

Planernaya (Krasnogorsk)--Former Zeiss-Ikon (Dresden) employees: Dr. GOERLICH, who formerly worked on infra-red developments, is now back in Dresden.

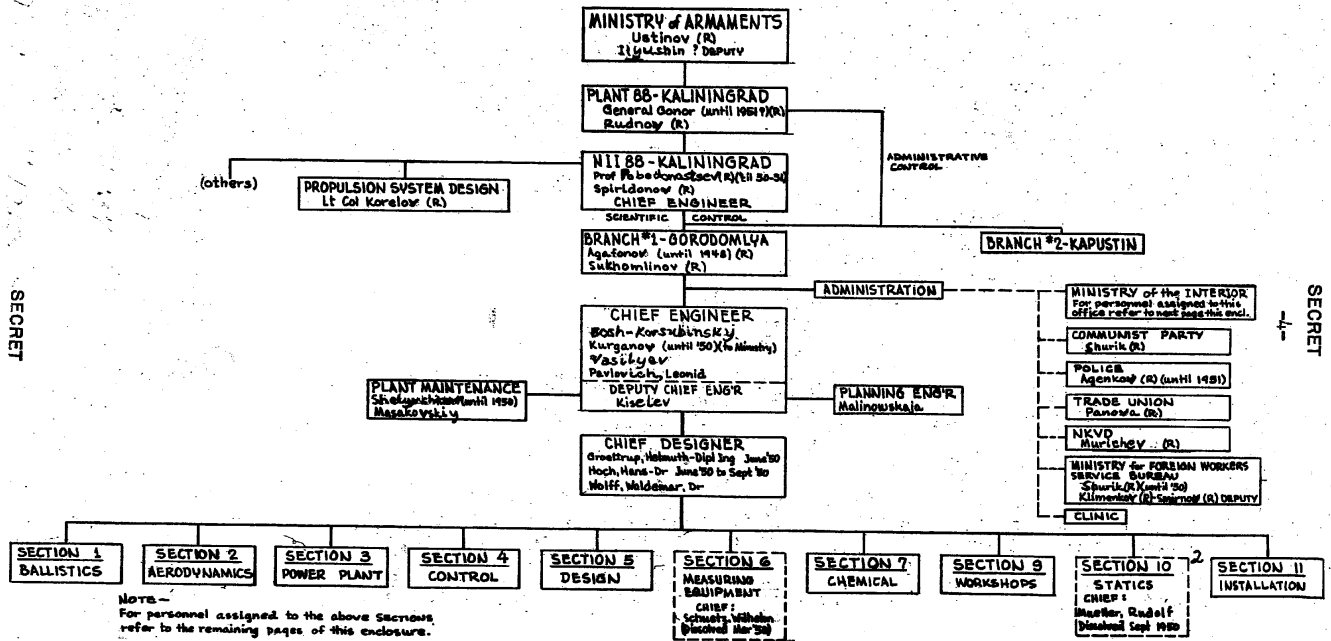
