1. <u>comment</u>. The units of the 3d Gds AT Arty Brig appear to have been at their quarters in the barracks installation on Ulmenstrasse and in the Futlitz Kaserne until 22 April. The equipment of a brigade as indicated in paragraph 3 of the report corresponds to that of an AT brigade with two medium and 1 heavy AT regiment, as they are still in existence with the 4th AT Arty Brig (US) of the IV Arty Corps. In 1952, when the brigade was reassigned from the Third Shock Army to the IV Arty Corps, the brigade probably exchanged for AT guns the field howitzers with which it had been equipped at that time and, thus, confirmed with the requirements of the IV Arty Corps which already had an artillery division equipped with high-angle weapons.
