 Between 8:30 a.m. and 3.p.m. on 21 April 1953, "lener Neustadt (0 48/X 34) airfield was occupied by the following aircraft:

60 MiG-15s, including 13 in front of the hangars on the eastern edge of the pyrotechnic plant, on which maintenance or overhauling work was in progress, 22 on the dispersal area near the flight control station, 24 in or next to the revetments near Badener Strasse, and 1 in the Therasien aircraft repair shop.

These MiG-15s had red or light blue stripes about 10 cm wide along the upper edge of the rudder assembly:

9 twin-jet planes near the flight control station, including 7 with blue stripes on the upper edge of the rudder assembly; 6 single-engine planes, 3 biplanes and about 10 Fe-2s near the large temporary building at the northeastern end of the pyrotechnic plant.

At 11 a.m., 2 MiG-15s simultaneously landed at the field. There was a O/10 overcast, a northeasterly wind of about 10 km/h and good visibility. No more air activity was observed. There was intensive activity at the field and near the aircraft, which were parked in or near the revetments. Many trucks, van-like trucks, tank trucks and small Moskovich van-like trucks end trucks with mounted searchlights were observed at the field.

2. The AA gun emplacements along Wiener Neusladt-Bad Fischau road and near Badener Strasse were occupied by guns. About 15 trucks were parked in the vicinity. Funkers apparently underground quarters had been built near the AA gun emplacements. Chimneys and roof's projected beyond the ground and billeting equipment was seen nearby. Lange finders were observed near the AA gun emplacements between the church and the Woellersdorfer Strasse railroad stop. They were connected with telephone lines to the other AA gun emplacements. There were also underground bunkers. No
