From 9 to 10 a.m. on 20 April 1953, Trauersdorf (P 48/K 55) airfield was unoccupied. A radar set consisting of two x-shaped rods with two dipole carriers fitted with seven dipoles each. The radar set was about 100 meters east of the quartering building where a braced antenna mast was seen in the spring of 1952. Near this point, a small mast supporting a frame fitted with wires from which projected a dipole carrier to the fore and aft at a right angle. A rod antenna 4 to 5 meters high was also seen.
