1. On 25 April 1953, the 1st VPL division supply headquarters was transferred from Bautzen to Augustusbad. Construction work at Bautzen airfield was ordered to be completed by 16 May 1953. Subsequently, practice flights with jet planes were to be made at the field. The division headquarters of the air division probably was to be transferred from Cottbus to Bautzen.1

1. [redacted] Comment. A previous report contained the first information on the existence of a VPL technical division. [redacted] This division headquarters is superior to the three air technical battalions which are assigned to the three VPL regiments. [redacted]

[redacted] It is believed that the target date for completion of construction work at Bautzen-Litten airfield will be slightly delayed since a length of only 1,000 meters of the auxiliary runway had been completed by 18 May 1953. Presumably, work will progress quickly.
