1. Between 4 p.m. and 5:30 p.m. on 19 May 1953,

trucks

with drivers wearing

black-bordered blue epaulets, were parked near the flight control station at Wiener Neustadt airfield.

2. The Artillerie Kaserne at Wiener Neustadt military post was guarded by sentries wearing black-bordered blue epaulets and, apparently, the occupation of the barracks had not changed. No changes were observed at the radio installation in the northwestern corner of the barracks yard and the rod antenna on the roof of the western barracks building. The radio truck with rod antenna in the western section of the barracks installation had been removed.

3. The Nachrichten Kaserne apparently was lightly occupied. Six motor vehicles including tank truck the driver wearing black-bordered blue epaulets, and truck were parked in the barracks yard. Truck was observed moving to the former military academy.
