- 6. The specialized courses last two months. They are attended by the officers divided into two series. Each series is composed of 60 to 80 officers. The courses deal with general theoretical information and emphasize the preparedness against a chemical attack, as well as the practical measures to be taken in such circumstances. The coursesalso teach how to build shelters and how to train civilians in civil defense.
- 7. Three or four times a year, the chiefs of civil defense of large cities and industrial centers visit the Chemical Center. At these periodic meetings the matters discussed pertain to the betterment of the civil defense system.
