1. As a result of the June 1953 mass demonstrations, the Ministerial Council of East Germany has decided to release chemicals and pharmaceutical goods from the State Reserves to consumers, to the extent of 19,000,000 eastmarks.
2. Textiles to the value of 22,000,000 eastmarks will also be released.
3. The release of leather goods has also been ordered; to what extent is, however, still uncertain.
4. Guenther Finzsch has been charged with handling these releases.
