1. [Redacted] the Schwerin regional railroad headquarters was ordered to furnish one train daily for the shipment of cement from Wisnar to Parchim after 26 May 1953. 1

2. Soviet shipments dispatched from Brest Litovsk to Frankfurt/Oder included 10 railroad repair shop cars each equipped with a boring machine and a lathe and consigned to the marshaling yard on 4 June, and 4 flatcars with four 37-mm AA guns on 5 June.

3. [Redacted] a train of 34 boxcars from Altengrabow to Brest Litovsk, [Redacted] on 21 June. 2 Also indicated was a train of 2 boxcars and 29 flatcars from Frankfurt/Oder to Satz Korn, [Redacted]

[Redacted] a train of 31 cars with a load of 600 tons from Altengrabow to Frankfurt/Oder, [Redacted] on 16 June and a train of 34 boxcars with a load of 752 tons from Altengrabow to Brest Litovsk, [Redacted] on 21 June. 2 A train of 1 boxcar and 29 flatcars with a load of 947 tons went from Frankfurt/Oder to Satz Korn, [Redacted]

1. [Redacted] Comment. The shipments are probably connected with the improvement of a Soviet airfield in the Parchim area.

2. [Redacted] Comment. Probably return to the USSR of empty shells from the ammunition depot of the Third Shock Army.
