Between 6 and 17 July 1953, the Infanterie Kaserne in Rathenow was occupied by about 200 troops wearing red-bordered black epaulets with artillery insignia.

The Pionier Kaserne was occupied by about 150 troops wearing red-bordered black epaulets with artillery insignia. Motor vehicles [redacted]
