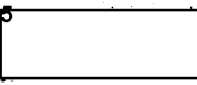

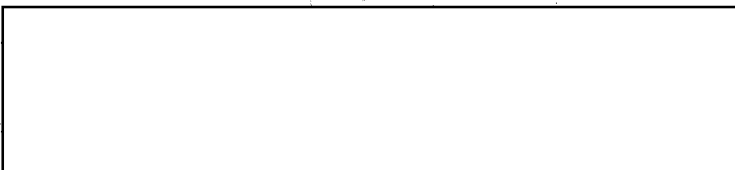

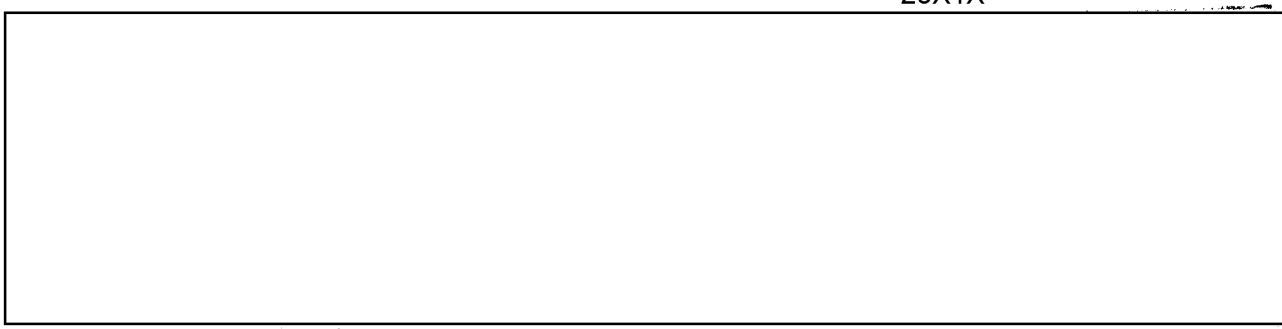

At 5:45 on 20 June 1953, a Polish tug towing a new merchant vessel on a westerly course was seen at a distance of 2,000 meters, 18 sea miles off Schöpin, true 170 degrees. Source was unable to identify the name of the ship, but believed that it was SZCZECIN.
