1. A military unit is quartered in ul. Lakowa in Gdansk (Danzig); the men wear round caps with light blue bands, similar in color to those used by the police. A truck leaving the barracks The driver, the officer, and a soldier in the truck wore cap bands as mentioned above. 25X1

2. Army officers seen leaving the naval barracks in Gdynia - Grabowek (former Bloki Emigracyjne), one at a time, in the late afternoon of 24 June 1953 wore red cap-bands and dark red (Bordeaux) collar patches with crossed forked lightning. 2

1. Comment: Probably a KBW (Internal Security Corp) unit.

2. Comment: Crossed "forked lightning" is the emblem of Signals. The difference between the color of the cap-bands and the collar patches was remarked 25X1
