25X1 [] the Official Timetable for Soviet Passenger and Freight Railroad Traffic through Poland [] went into effect on 17 May 1953. This timetable, issued by the Polish Railroad administration in three languages, German, Russian and Polish, is also binding on the German locomotive brigades operating for the Soviets through Poland.

25X1 [] As compared with the old timetable, there are the following changes:

25X1 a. One train each bound to Kutno and Czeremcha via Frankfurt/Oder has been cancelled.

25X1 b. One train bound for Brest-Litovsk via Frankfurt/Oder has been added. Thus the total of transit trains decreased from 36 to 35 including 1 express train, 2 leave trains, and 33 freight trains. Contrary to information available to this office, the timetable [] indicates that the Siedlce-Czeremcha line section is still single-track.
