A train consisting of six passenger coaches and 25 boxcars passed through Frankfurt/Oder on 16 September, enroute from Jueterbog-Altes Lager toward Brest Litovsk. The train was occupied by air force officers, their dependents and luggage.

Comment: The officers presumably belonged to the IL-28 unit which was transferred from Jueterbog-Altes Lager to the USSR in early July.
