- 3. Troops were observed leaving Camp Vogelsang, near Templin, for maneuvers after 1 October. <sup>3</sup>
- 4. On 6 October, an advance detail of the unidentified engineer regiment of the GDFG entered the barracks installation in Bernburg.
- 5. On 3 October, an artillery unit with 12 to 14 motor vehicles of the 207th Rifle Division and 8 x 76.2 mm field guns entered the Flugplatz Kaserne in Quedlinburg. <sup>4</sup>

- 1. Elements of the IX Rifle Corps returning from the final exercise of the 3rd Shock Army in the Letzling Heath-Rathenow-Genthin area. [redacted]

  - 3. Major elements of the 25th Tank Division participated in major exercises in the area north of Berlin prior to 5 October. [redacted]
