25X1A	3.	Comment. The apparent renaming of the Oranienburg alert force into I Mecz Command is indicative of a reassignment of the unit. The alert force was subordinate directly to the Ministry of the Interior. The Potsdam alert force also seems to have been renamed into mechanized command. This unit had also been subordinate directly to the Ministry of the Interior. It may be noted that the Hohenstuecken alert force, which is or was also subordinate directly to the Ministry of the Interior, is not mentioned in connection with the Berlin VP alert force, which seems to have been recently organized. Since it would have been possible to integrate the Hohenstuecken alert force as III Mecz Command into the Berlin VP alert force, it appears strange that, instead, the Klietz alert force, which was subordinate to the
