The following military units and installations are located in Rzeszow:

- a. An artillery regiment is stationed in the pre-war barracks at Pobitna.
- b. Antiaircraft artillery sites are located at Baranowka, on the outskirts of Rzeszow.
- c. An army unit wearing green uniforms is quartered in barracks located near Czwartakow park.
- d. A special KBW (Corps of Internal Security) unit with about 50 or 60 police dogs (Siberian wolf-dogs) is stationed in three 3-story barracks.<sup>1</sup> A KBW training center is located at Blonie, near Rzeszow, in the direction of Slocina and Tyczyn villages. Six or seven companies were observed taking part in exercises.
