3. Shipments observed in Frankfurt/Oder en route from Brest Litovsk in the direction of Eberswalde included 25 flatcars with 25 trucks with van-like superstructures on 3 October, and 8 flatcars with 12 trucks on 8 October.⁵

4. [redacted] a total of 707 and 63 carloads of grain entered East Germany via the Frankfurt/Oder and Guben border stations respectively in September.⁶

1. [redacted] Comment. Deliveries of East German hydrogenation plants to the USSR.

2. [redacted] Comment. Intrazonal supply shipment to the Soviet fuel depot in Velten.

3. [redacted] Comment. Uranium ore shipments to the USSR. [redacted]

4. [redacted] Comment. New railroad cars delivered to the USSR. The Soviet-gauge wheel sets will be used on these cars in the USSR.

5. [redacted] Comment. These shipments were either consigned to the Soviet Army or the KVP.

6. [redacted] Comment. In September, a total of 760 empty boxcars for grain shipments were dispatched to the USSR. [redacted] compared with August 1952, grain imports decreased by 50 percent. [redacted]
