- 1. In Fukien the political committee of a special administrative area is a subordinate echelon of the Central Committee of the Chinese Communist Party. The political committee of the Lungch'i (N 24-32, E 117-42) Special Administrative Area is an example. Senior members of the Party who are from the area serve on this committee in addition to carrying out their government functions. Normally the administrative area commissioner acts as chairman, although occasionally a permanent secretary is appointed to this position by the next higher echelon.
- 2. Five departments are under the direction of the Lungch'i Political Committee. Each department has a chief, assistant chief, and three tofive administrative assistants. The five departments are: Organization, Propaganda, Administrative, Secretarial, and Cultural and Educational.
- 3. Ultimate authority rests with the secretary of the committee and not with the commissioner. Each area committee administers a staff member training school. All executives within the Party machinery, or staff members who have elected to become executives within the Party machinery, are required to go through this school. All members of the special administrative area Party organization wear a circular badge with red characters on a silver background.
- 4. The hsien political committee controls areas within the special administrative area. The organization of the hsien committee parallels that of the special administrative area, as follows:
 - a. Senior staff members of the Party who are from the same hsien serve on the committee in addition to carrying out their regular government functions.
 - b. The hsien magistrate generally acts as committee chairman; otherwise a secretary is appointed by the special administrative area committee.
