1. [REDACTED] Comment. Grunow is crossing station between the Berlin railroad district and the Cottbus railroad district. The tank shipment was probably forwarded to Spremberg, where a tank unit of the KVP is stationed. 25X1

2. [REDACTED] Comment. It is undetermined which KVP unit is stationed in Premnitz. According to information by deserters, an engineer battalion which allegedly was to transfer to Hohenstuecken, had been stationed there in September and October 1953. An artillery unit allegedly was to be activated in Premnitz. 25X1
