From 9 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. on 29 October 1953, labor details were engaged in excavation work in the billeting area of the Adolf Hitler Kaserne. Tree trunks, 5 meters long and 30 cm in diameter, were hauled to the installation. Maintenance work was done on 12 trucks. At 10 a.m., 90 soldiers returned from bathing. Small groups totaling about 35 officers and 70 soldiers were in the streets in Bernburg. Stores for potatoes were dug out at the cemetery. 25X1

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
