1. The railroads are soon to come under Army management and an Army general is to be the head of the Ministry of Railroads<sup>1</sup>. Railroad personnel are to get Army-type uniforms and a special military disciplinary and penal code will be issued for the railroad service, according to the Soviet model.
2. The staff of the Ministry of Railroads in Prague, which amounts to 2,000 persons, is to be cut considerably. Before World War II, the entire Ministry of Transportation had a staff of only 700.

25X1  Comment. The government reorganization of 14 September 1953 re-combined the Ministry of Railroads with the Ministry of Transportation to form the present Ministry of Transportation.
