- 25X1  1. On 19 November 1953, the Panzer Kaserne, Neubrandenburg, was occupied as previously. About 80 percent of the windows of the installation were lighted after nightfall. Sentries observed wore red-bordered black epaulets with tank insignia. On 18 and 19 November, 80 troops were drilling. No other training was observed.

- 25X1  2. On 16 October, 60 tanks, which had arrived from the direction of Berlin, were detrained in Cammin and engaged in driving practice near Gramelow. Subsequently, the tanks leveled the rutted area.
3. On 5 November, a shipment of 35 armored vehicles was seen at the Neubrandenburg railroad station, proceeding toward Berlin.
4. On 7 November, a column of about 400 troops was seen en route to the Neubrandenburg market place, coming from the railroad station.
