1. [] Chinese Communist troops had vacated the buildings at 2 and 228 Waimalu (1120/7456/6424), Swatow. The former was being used for rice storage and the latter was sealed. 25X1
2. [] approximately 50 troops occupied 228 Waimalu. Approximately 120 troops were in the Hsinchiyuan (2450/4764/0337) Hotel on Chihp'ing (5267/1627) Road. 25X1
3. [] troops had vacated 7 Waimalu, which was sealed. Approximately 350 troops occupied the two buildings and two tents at 217 Waimalu. 25X1
