The table that follows allegedly gives the number and capacity of floating liquid fuel tanks (Tank Leichter) in East Germany. 1/ The tanks are stationed in the inland port of Magdeburg. They fall under the administration of the Deutsche Schifffahrts- und Umschlagunion but are assigned to various factories which do not have adequate storage space for their needs. 2/

25X1A 1/  Comment: These are actually stationary barges with tank capacity, not tank 11 liters.

25X1A 2/  Comment: For instance, two such floating tankers are assigned for the use of the Buna-~~werk~~ Schkopau; these two contain benzene. One barge is for the use of Farbenfabrik Agfa Wolfen and also contains benzene; the Leuna-~~Werke~~ uses one which contains petroleum.
