During the period from 1 October 1953 to 11 October 1953, no Polish partisan or sabotage activity came to the attention of German railroaders traveling the Frankfurt/Oder-Brest-Litovsk line.

2. Between 8 and 11 October 1953 only three or four trains travelled from Frankfurt to Brest per day. There was usually one uranium train, one gasoline train, one refrigerator train, and perhaps one empty train.
3. Between 8 and 11 October only five or six trains per day travelled from Brest to Frankfurt; 60 percent of them carried iron ore for processing, and the other 40 percent were empty.
4. According to rumors circulating among brigade members, the brigades are to be disbanded on 1 January 1954, because all reparations shipments will cease as of that date. 1/
