25X1 1. Military shipments dispatched from Dallgow to Dannenwalde between 23 December 1953 and 6 January 1954 included: 6 flatcars with 18 x 76.2-mm AT guns hauled by trucks [redacted] on 23 December; 9 boxcars, probably with ammunition, on 26 December; and 1 converted boxcar, 5 boxcars, and 9 flatcars with 26 x 76.2-mm AT guns hauled by trucks [redacted] on 6 January.<sup>1</sup> 25X1

25X1 2. [redacted] on 9 January, a troop train of 42 cars, [redacted] was dispatched from Felkenberg to Neubrandenburg.<sup>2</sup> 25X1

25X1 3. [redacted] a KVF train of 1 converted boxcar and 6 flatcars, [redacted] went from Jueterbog Altes Lager to Dohrlug -Kirchhain on 7 January.<sup>3</sup> 25X1

25X1 4. [redacted] on and after 28 December, empty trains of coaches escorted by Soviet military personnel have been dispatched to Brest Litovsk via Frankfurt/Oder; and [redacted] by the Frankfurt/Oder railroad office, [redacted] the trains were special trains for transportation of Soviet dependents to the zone. [redacted] 25X1  
 [redacted] the trains would be used for reshipping of military personnel from furlough.<sup>4</sup> 25X1

25X1 1. [redacted] Comment. The shipments again confirm the turning in of 76.2-mm guns to the ordnance collecting depot of the Second Gds Meck Army. [redacted] 25X1  
 [redacted] the brigade probably has turned in all guns of this type. 25X1  
 [redacted] Comment 3. As [redacted] 25X1  
 [redacted] the 26 x 76.2-mm guns loaded on 6 January 1954 belonged to the 1st Meck Div, it is believed that the division has so far turned in two-thirds of its gun equipment. AT guns of 85 mm which [redacted] 25X1  
 [redacted] arrived from the USSR, are so far observed at barracks 25X1
