On 30 December , 2 prime movers, each towing a 100-mm AT gun and carrying 10 soldiers were seen in the barracks yard. The guns were subsequently em-About 70 soldiers received close-order drill. On 9 January, rlaced. about 60 soldiers received gun drill with 4 x 100-mm AT guns and 2 x 120-mm field howitzers in the barracks yard. On 11 January, 4 prime movers, each towing a 122-mm field howitzer, and 2 trucks, each carrying about 35 men left the installation toward Langenberg. At about 1 p.m., 2 prime movers, each towing 25X1 a 100-mm AT gun entered the installation, coming from the direction of Hainberg. 25X1 On 12 January, 3 prime movers, each towing a 100-mm AT gun and 2 trucks 25X1 entered the installation, coming from the direction of langenham On 12 January, the Fanzer Kaserne in Tinz quartered about 300 to 350 men. Between 28 December 1953 and 12 January 1954, about 60 soldiers daily received basic training with carbines in the barracks area. No vehicular traffic was noticed. 1 25X1 25X1 100-mm AI guns were parked in roofed sheds, with only the barrels proloopholes, pointing toward north. A dummy village was established truding from a distance of 750 to 1,000 meters from the guns. Uniformed women were also seen in the emplacement.
