## Observations at Ruegen Island included:

a. Glowe Project  25X1

- (1) No work of any kind was going on. There are no workers, prisoners, or dredgers in the area.
- (2) The canal runs in a gentle bow shape, mean direction 200° - 020°, with the open part of the bow facing east. Its length is about half dug to a depth of 25-30 ft. The ends are still dammed off, and a dam stretches across the Spycker See from Weddeort. The Spycker See itself is now only a marsh.
- (3) A W/T station was established in a newly-built white house to the east of the canal and about halfway between the coast and the Glowe/Ruschvitz road.
- (4) A light railway was built running through Weddeort, from about halfway along the canal to the Spycker See due south of Weddeort.
- (5) There are no indications of any U-boat bunkers in the Spycker See.

b. Sassnitz  25X1

- (1) The harbor to the north of the Sassnitz ferry is devoted solely to the Fischkombinat. The large building at the northern end of the harbor is the ice factory where there were three loggers and cutters of 18 and 24 m.
- (2) The buildings house offices, accommodations for the crews, a fire station, a small repair shop and fish processing sheds.

c. Stralsund  25X1

- (1) Only fishing craft and small refrigerator vessels were to be seen. Apart from a very small number of "KS-Boote", nothing except fishing vessels were to be seen either in the former Staatswerft or at the Volkswerft.
