<u>Comment</u>. The furniture was shipped away by trucks of the 10th Gds Tank Div. This observation, in connection with the mortars seen, tends to indicate that the 299th Gds Mort Regt of the division from Brandenburg transferred to the Kriegsschule in Potsdam, which, so far, had only partially been occupied. The regiment would thus have followed the 63d Gds Tank Regt of the division which, in late October, transferred from Brandenburg to the Adolf Hitler Kaserne in Potsdam. Pertinent information from Brandenburg has not yet been received.
