On 16 December 1953, negotiations were conducted at the Ministry for Coal in Warsaw between the representatives of the VEB Designs Bureau for Industrial Construction Work at 1 Am Koellnischen Park in Berlin O 17 and representatives of the Polish State Commission for Economic Planning on the erection of the Brown Coal Combine in Konin. In the course of these negotiations, the Poles stated that they were interested in advancing the completion dates for the designs involved, because they were already eight weeks behind schedule in the completion of the plan for the combine. In connection with these endeavours, representatives of the Polish designs bureaus involved went to Berlin in order to obtain the help of German experts.
2. [REDACTED] the enlargement of the water plant in Konin was in full swing during the reported period. 25X1
