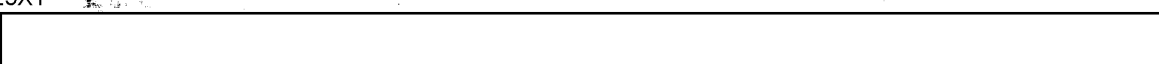

1. During October or November 1953 Polish military units returned to Stalinogrod from summer camps. The returning units were motorized infantry, equipped with self-propelled guns, 105-mm field guns and 126-mm howitzers. Also observed were sixteen type-34 tanks, and seven type-A2 tanks; the tanks were equipped with 76-mm anti-tank guns. A large number of jet aircraft flew over during the review.
2. A group of USSR mining experts arrived in Stalinogrod during October or November. The experts contacted the Ministry of Mining there. The purpose of their visit was not known.
