- 3. There are numerous engineering units equipped with armored cars in the Vilnyus area. Large stores of war materials have been deposited alongside roads and railroads. Preparations indicate that the Soviet units are forming large and strong offensive groups.
- 4. About 15 large, modern airfields, which were either constructed after World War II or modernized from old fields, are located in the Vilnyus and Baranovichi (N 53-08, E25-02) area. Nearly all the aircraft located on these fields are single or twin-engine jet aircraft and large transport planes, each of the latter of which is capable of carrying 120 soldiers.
