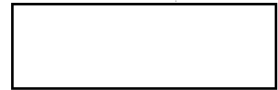

25X1 4. [redacted] westbound shipments from Brest Litovsk on 6 February

5. [redacted] the following shipments were dispatched from  
 Frankfurt/Oder to Altengradow on 8 February: 17 boxcars, [redacted]  
 2 and 15 flatcars and 7 empty gondola cars, [redacted]

1. [redacted] Comment. These trucks were probably consigned to Soviet units. A motor  
 vehicle repair shop and distribution point of the Third Shock Army is located  
 at Ziesar, while a tank spare parts depot of the GOPG is located at Muellrose.  
 The latter appears unusual as consignee for motor vehicles.

2. [redacted] Comment. Ammunition shipments from the USSR. Large Soviet ammunition depots  
 are located at Altengradow and Kapen. The shipment of 3 February listed in para-  
 graph 1 may either have been consigned to the Waldeslust ammunition depot of the  
 Fourth Gds Mech Army or to the ammunition depot of the Twenty-Fourth Air Army  
 located at the Biesenthal estate which is served via Eberswalde-Finow, the latter  
 of which appears more credible. The report confirms that index figure 40 [redacted]  
 [redacted] have been used for ammunition shipments from the  
 USSR after January 1954.

3. [redacted] Comment. Deliveries to the Foundry Combine East at Fuerstenberg/Oder.

4. [redacted] Comment. Uranium ore shipments to the USSR which are assigned index figure  
 69 and shipment numbers of the 22xxx block.

5. [redacted] Comment. This shipment may either have been consigned to the ordnance depot  
 of the GOPG which transferred from Jessen to Justerbog or to units of the Third  
 Gds Mech Army stationed at Justerbog.

6. [redacted] Comment. Ration supply deliveries from the USSR to Soviet ration supply depots.  
 7. [redacted] Comment. Grain shuttle trains. In January 1954, a total of 2,182 loaded  
 and 4,123 empty grain shuttle cars passed through Frankfurt/Oder.

8. [redacted] Comment. From the shipment-record number, the type of cars and the receiving  
 station mentioned, it is inferred that the shipment possibly consisted of artillery  
 prime movers.
