The Jaeger Kaserne (3341), Luebben, which, in early March 1954, had been occupied by about 900 troops wearing red-bordered black epaulets with tank insignia, was occupied by only about 200 troops on 16 March. Only a few vehicles, including radio truck [redacted] were stationed in the installation. The Landessanstat (3343) 25X1 Luebben, which, in early March, had been occupied by about 250 troops wearing red-bordered black epaulets, was occupied by not more than 100 troops on 16 March. A [redacted] the troops had been entrained on 15 March. On 4 March, about 20 trucks, about 8 T-34/85 tanks [redacted] and 1 armored scout car were seen in the yard of Jaeger Kaserne. On the same day, 20 flatcars with sideracks and a few boxcars were seen at the railroad station. The cars were still empty on 5 March.

Comment. The information confirms the impression that exercises of the 9th Mech Div were conducted in early March. [redacted] a shipment of the 91st Tank Regt stationed in the Jaeger Kaserne went to Spremberg on 6 March. [redacted] loadings for Brand in Cottbus on 8 March.
