- 1. Attached is a rough sketch of Mielno (Gross Moeller) which is located on the coast near Koszalin (Koeslin), showing a restricted military area.
- 2. Sentries patrol the entire length of the beach day and night. A curfew is in force between sundown and 0600 hours. Two Soviet soldiers were once seen in the area, but normally only WOP (Military Border Guard) troops are in evidence.


- a. Asphalt road 8 meters wide.
