25X1 1. At 9:30 p.m. on 11 March 1954, about 6 T-34/85 tanks, [REDACTED] about 10 trucks and 5 boxcars were loaded at the Altstrelitz railroad station. 1

25X1 2. At 4 p.m. on 13 March, 7 boxcars, 12 trucks, 2 jeeps and T-34/85 tanks [REDACTED] were loaded at the Neustrelitz railroad station and left toward Berlin. 2

25X1 3. On 13 March, 4 M-13 rocket launchers, 3 x 120-mm mortars [REDACTED] were detained at the Neustrelitz railroad station and presumably left for the Schlossgarten restricted area [REDACTED] and Grenadier Kaserne [REDACTED]. 3

25X1 4. On 14 March, tanks [REDACTED] and 2 trucks, each with a field kitchen [REDACTED] were entrained at the Neustrelitz railroad station. 4

25X1 5. At about 9 a.m. on 13 March, 30 to 35 trucks were seen in the yard of the Grenadier Kaserne. The vehicles had presumably been unloaded during the preceding night. [REDACTED] These vehicles had presumably also been unloaded during the preceding night. 3

25X1 1. [REDACTED] Comment. If the tanks belonged to a unit of the Second Gds Mech Army, they may have belonged to the 12th Gds Tank Div. Movements of units of this division to the Neustrelitz area were not observed during the first two weeks in March, however.

25X1 2. [REDACTED] Comment. Retransfer of tank details of the 1st Mech Div, which, on 7 March, went from Dallgow to Neustrelitz [REDACTED] for advanced combat practice firing.

- 25X1 3. [ ] Comment. The elements of the 9th Gds Tank Div which, on 8 March, transferred to Luckenwalde from Neustrelitz, returned from there with mortars, rocket launchers and howitzers [ ] on 13 March.
- 25X1 4. [ ] Comment. [ ] probably a shipment of tanks of the unidentified tank training battalion of the 9th Gds Tank Div, which returned to Neubrandenburg after the completion of advanced combat practice firing.
