### 1. Kaposvar.

- a. Since December 1953 the Vehicle Repair Enterprise (Autojavito Vallalat), which is located at Iranyi Ut and is requisitioned by the Hungarian Army, has been undertaking repair work for civilian vehicles.
- b. About 12-15 Hungarian soldiers were seen working in the repair shop at the beginning of December 1953. All previous repair work had been carried out by civilian mechanics.

#### 2. Tamasi.

In October 1953, about 400 recruits entered the barracks north of Tamasi. The regruits came for the most part from east of the Tisza, Transdanubia, Pécs, and Gyor.

# 3. Szekszárd.

- a. The barracks on the southeastern edge of Szekszard, about 300m. southwest of the Szekszard railroad station, are occupied by the headquarters of a rifle regiment and two rifle battalions. In October 1953, 500-600 recruits moved into the barracks.
- b. The regiment is not motorized. It is equipped with four or five SU-76 SP guns, 8-10 76.2 mm. field guns, and several 80 mm? mortars. The field guns and mortars are horse-drawn.
