25X1 2. Comment. On 18 March 1954, [redacted] the departure of four troop trains from Halle-Ammendorf to the Erfurt railroad district.

25X1 The six troop trains reported in the present report hauled components of the 21st Gds Mech Div to field exercises which also included contingents of the 57th Gds Mts Rifle

25X1 Div and were held in the Ordruf-Gotha area on about 18, 19 and 20 March 1954. Components of the 21st Gds Mech Div in Halle [redacted] included: the 54th Gds

25X1 4. Comment. The troop trains from Grimma and Wurzen carried contingents of the 8th Gds Mech Div to Field exercises at division level in the Koenigsbrueck-Zeithain area.

25X1 5. Comment. Between 6 and 17 March 1954, units returned from Schwebnitz to their home stations after termination of combat firing practice at the Koenigsbrueck troop training grounds. The troop trains from Chemnitz probably carried components of the 6th Gds AAA Div (US).
