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1. Comment. These are the first bauxite shipments reported in 1954. Definitely no bauxite arrived in East Germany during January 1954, while it was not determined whether bauxite shipments were effected during February. 25X1

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2. Comment. Crude oil shipments from Austria in March amounted to a total of 2,221 tank cars carrying 34,399 tons; this is an increase of 2,297 tons over the volume of February shipments. 25X1

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3. Comment. Aviation gasoline dispatched to the USSR. 25X1

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4. Comment. These shipments were dispatched from the Foundry Combine East at Puerstenberg/Oder (Stalinstadt). 25X1

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5. Comment. In March, uranium ore exports to the USSR totaled 630 cars with 9,580 tons, while in February a total of 624 carloads was reported. In 1953, a monthly average of 600 carloads of uranium ore was dispatched to the USSR. 25X1

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
